ADULT CONFIRMANDS



Any adults who have not been Confirmed and any Converts who plan to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on April 18, please complete an application by **this Wednesday, April 1st**. Forms can be picked up at the Parish Office. A current copy of your baptismal registry is needed at the time of registration.

EASTER BASKETS will be blessed by the priest after each Mass on Easter Sunday, excluding the Easter Vigil Mass. Baskets can be brought to the main vestibule for this blessing.

CONCERNING LENTEN OBSERVANCES

GOOD FRIDAY FAST AND ABSTINENCE

IS OBLIGATORY UNDER PAIN OF MORTAL SIN.

The *law of abstinence* binds all Catholics (beginning on the day after their 14th birthday), and forbids the use of meat, but not of eggs, the products of milk, or condiments made of animal fat.

The *law of fasting* binds all adults (beginning on their 18th birthday until the midnight which completes their 59th birthday). The law of fasting allows only one full meal a day but does not prohibit taking some food in the morning and evening, observing – as far as quantity and quality are concerned – approved local custom.

Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices, are allowed. Meat may not be eaten, but fish and all cold-blooded animals (e.g. frogs, clams, turtles, etc.) may be consumed.

SEATING IN THE CHURCH During the Holy Week ceremonies seating is on a first-come, first-served basis. Seats may **not** be saved for people who have not yet arrived. However if you are already seated and have to leave briefly, ask someone nearby to save your seat for you.

Additional chairs will be set up in the church along the pews, as at Christmas; extra seating will also be available in the Parish Hall on Holy Thursday and Good Friday so the ceremonies can be heard and viewed on the screens.
