EASTER LITURGICAL NOTES

Until the Vigil of Pentecost:

- on the feasts of apostles and martyrs a special common is used
- the Gradual is replaced by an Alleluia with its versicle
- the Gloria is said at Sunday masses celebrated during the week
- at Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament an Alleluia is added to the versicle *Panem de caelo* and its responsory

EASTER BASKETS will be blessed by a priest **after each Mass Today**. Baskets can be brought to the main vestibule for this blessing.

The Parish Office will be closed tomorrow, Easter Monday.
