NEW AND RETURNING STUDENT ENROLLMENTS REMINDER:

IMPORTANT: Enrollment and re-enrollment is open for both new students (*who have received a letter of acceptance*) and **returning students**. Even though an application has been completed and submitted, parents must “accept” any resulting offer letters sent by email AND enroll their new students. Of the 65 offers sent for new kindergarten and 1st graders so far, 39 have not accepted the offer and enrolled their new student. Of the 797 returning students, 366 have not started the re-enrollment process. If you have questions, please contact the registrar at x475. Please use FACTS to complete the enrollment process.

Please note: Parents must complete the enrollment of new students and re-enrollment of returning students by **THIS FRIDAY**, April 30 to have student enrollment fees waived.
