SACRAMENTAL & CATECHISM CLASSES FOR NON-ACADEMY STUDENTS

First Holy Communion class and *Confirmation class* will **begin on SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 28** in the Immaculata classrooms (located adjacent to the Parish Hall).

Catechism Classes for boys only *not* preparing for the above sacraments will also take place in the Immaculata classrooms and begin on Sunday, **September 28** for *grades 9-12* and on **October 12** for *grades 5-8*.
