PARISH INFORMATION FORMS

All families receiving the sacraments should have an **Assumption Chapel Information Form** (revised in 2019) on file with the parish secretary.

New families should fill out a form when they move here. Changes (marriages especially) should be reported using the same form marked as an update (only changed information needs to be filled in).

If you do not have a revised form on file or have updates to make (address and other contact information), forms are available in the vestibule, at the switchboard, or by requesting a fillable electronic form from info@smac.edu which can be completed, printed, and turned in. If a family moves away from the parish, they should call the switchboard to let them know so that information can be updated as well.

NOVEMBER INDULGENCES FOR THE POOR SOULS

Conditions for the faithful to gain a plenary indulgence, applicable only to the Holy Souls in Purgatory:

- State of grace at least when performing the indulgenced act
- Complete detachment from sin, even venial sin
- Confession (20 days before or after)
- Communion (20 days before or after)
- Prayers for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff (20 days before or after)
- Visit of a cemetery with at least mental prayer for the poor souls - any 8 days in November (The visits do not have to be on consecutive days.)
- Visit of a church or an oratory (on *any* day in November) with one Our Father and one Creed recited
